# WHAT DOES FAST FORWARD INSURANCE, ING., DBA FAST FORWARD INSURANCE SERVICES DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives the consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information.

#### What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security Number and information you provide us on applications or other forms
- Payment history, transaction history we receive from you and others, and loss history
- Medical information and insurance claims history

When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Fast Forward Insurance, Inc. chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
